Dear Graeme.

I would like to welcome you to your new role as Chair of the Scottish Fiscal Commission (the Commission). I am writing, post publication of the Resource Spending Review (RSR), to confirm indicative funding for the Commission in line with the Commission's Framework document and OECD best practice for Independent Fiscal Institutions.

The Cabinet Secretary for Finance and the Economy wrote to your predecessor on 31 March setting out indictitive funding for 2023-24 and 2024-25 and actual funding for the current financial year. The Cabinet Secretary's letter also stated that officials would write to you to confirm the position post RSR. I can confirm the amounts, as set out below, remain unchanged and include in full the Commission's request for additional funding to support your work on longer term fiscal sustainability reporting. These figures reflect recent RSR exchanges regarding the Commission's projected expenditure and can be reviewed if circumstances change.
